Employment support for migrants and refugees

Sonder provides employment support for migrants and refugees living in northern and western Adelaide who are seeking work in the industries of health and community (aged care, disability, and childcare), agriculture, horticulture and food processing.

As part of the program, participants can also access support to help build resilience and improve their wellbeing.



Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this program, you must:

- Be a migrant or refugee aged between 16-64 years.
- Hold a valid Visa with working rights.
- Be participating in one of the the following programs: Jobactive, New Employment Services Trial, ParentNext or Transition to Work.
- Speak English proficiently.
- Live in Adelaide's northern or western region.

Participation in this program will count toward the individual's relevant Annual Activity Requirements (Jobactive), Mutual obligation Requirement (New Employment Services Trial) or Participation Requirements (ParentNext or Transition to Work).

Your Career Coach will work one-on-one with you to:

- Complete a vocational assessment to identify the jobs you would like to do.
- Develop tailored resumes, job applications and help you prepare for job interviews.
- Speak to employers on your behalf to identify job opportunities and work through any challenges that arise.
- Link you with relevant training.
- Access to workshops that cover issues including work related skills, peer support, workplace needs and the Australian work context.
- Gain industry specific clearances and tickets including police clearances, first aid, manual handling and forklift licences.
- Provide on-the-job support.

Your Wellbeing Coach can provide you with advice and support if you are:

- Having difficulties adjusting to your new home.
- Feeling down, stressed or can't stop worrying.
- Worried about your health or your family.
- Having difficulties with friendships or relationships.
- Having money trouble.
- Unable to sleep or concentrate.
- Experiencing loneliness.
