As vulnerable people attend our centres, we respectfully request that you:



Arrive on-time for your appointment



Stay in your vehicle or outside the building if you arrive early



Reschedule your appointment if you have any cold or flu-like symptoms



Cover coughs and sneezes and dispose of used tissues



Stay 1.5 m away from other people



Hand sanitise frequently



Wash your hands with soap and water after using the restrooms

Check-in using our QR code

As directed by SA Health, you are required to check-in.

Answer screening questions

Our staff will ask a set of screening questions relating to your physical health and whether you have been identified as a close contact of COVID-19 in the past 7 days.

Wear a mask

Anyone over the age of 12 will be required to wear a mask on site at all times. Should you hold an exemption from wearing a mask, you will be required to show us this upon arrival.
