

Information for health professionals

To be eligible for this program, patients must:

- Be enrolled for chronic disease management in a general practice or an Aboriginal Medical Service;
- Have a GP Management Plan and/or MBS 715 Health Check and;
- Be referred by their GP.

Priority will be given to clients who have complex needs, and require multidisciplinary coordinated care for their chronic disease.

Your Doctor or Aboriginal Health Worker will send a referral to Sonder.



Our team will contact you and arrange your first appointment.

Am I eligible?

To be able to join this service, you must:

- Identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander;
- Be enrolled for chronic disease management in a GP Practice or Aboriginal Health Service and;
- Be unable to effectively manage your chronic condition.
