Is this support right for me?

IEA may be right for you if you:

- Have a mental health condition that impacts your ability to work.
- Are aged 14 to 67 and an Australian resident.
- Can work from a few hours up to 30 hours per week.
- Are not studying full-time (unless you're an eligible school leaver).
- Are not already working at or above your assessed work capacity.

You do not need to be receiving income support to take part in IEA.
